Sacramental Preparation:

A two-year preparation process is required for the reception of the Sacraments of First Communion and First Penance (third grade) and Confirmation (junior year).

Sacrament of Baptism:

New members are welcomed into The Catholic Church through Baptism. Mandatory preparation classes are held four times a year. All parents must attend; Godparents are strongly encouraged to attend. Call the Parish Office for specific class dates.

Sacrament of Marriage:

Registered members are asked to contact the pastor six months to one year prior to the wedding. Participation in a Marriage Preparation Program is required.

Sacrament for the Sick/Homebound:

Please notify the Parish Office for household members who are elderly, disabled, ill or scheduled for surgery so that they may receive the Sacrament.

Words of Wisdom

*St. Francis Xavier Minister
October 20 & 21*

Today's first reading reminds us that the spirit of wisdom comes to those who pray for her. Wisdom, like the word of God, carries messages of challenge and consolation. The Letter to the Hebrews tells us the word of God is infused with The Father's wisdom and is "sharper than any two-edged sword." We cannot shrink from the wisdom of God, or from the word that has the power to penetrate our hearts and minds. As the *living* word of God, Jesus is the embodiment of wisdom. Jesus has strong, deeply penetrating words for the rich young man that goes to Jesus while searching for answers to his profound questions. Just when the young man thought he did enough to fulfill God's commands, more was asked of him. *This is just as true for each of us.*
