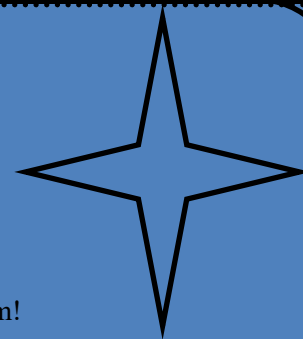

Basic Requirements For First Eucharist And Reconciliation Class

(1)At least 80% attendance to Catechism Classes from January 2019 (2) A 100% (except for cogent excuse communicated to the R.E. Director prior to meeting) attendance to Special Sacramental Classes. (3) A 100% (except cogent excuse communicated to the Priest prior) attendance to the 10:00am Mass from March 3, 2019 to the day the Sacrament is received. At this the children are expected to sit together in the front pews where they are expected to be attentive and show a sense of active participation. The child must be able to know the things that happen at Mass and the Responses at Mass. (4) The child must be able to know how to pray the Rosary (Chaplet) and recite the mysteries and participate in leading the recitation of the Rosary before Mass in the month of May. (5) The child must be able to recite, in order, the 10 Commandments which is a basic tool in preparing for Confession. (6) The child must know how to go to Confession. (7) The child must know some basic prayers like Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be, I Believe, Act of Contrition, Act of Faith, Act of Hope , Act of Charity, I Confess, Grace before and after Meals. (8) The child must show a manifest desire to receive the Sacrament as can be attested to by the Parents. Fee for the Sacrament is \$50.00 for books and materials. Starting on March 6th Father Selva will be taking the roll for the children who are preparing for their Sacraments.
