Mother Cabrini Shrine Trip

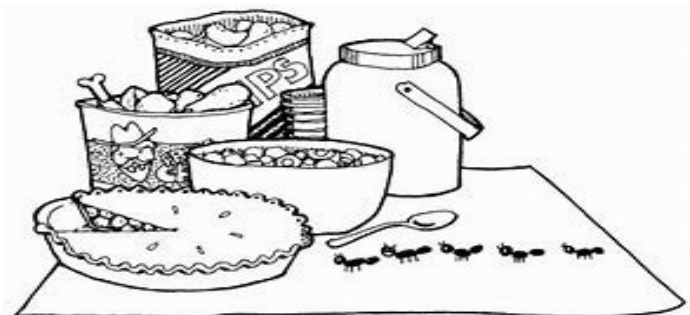

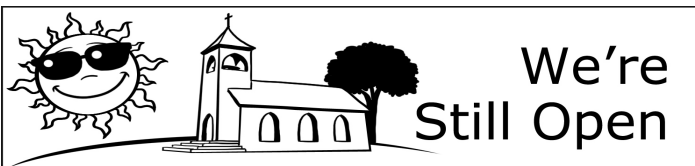
