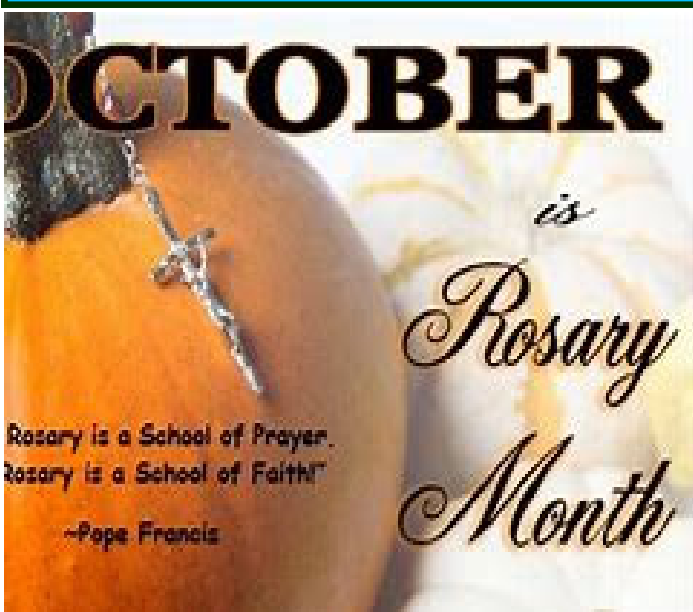

GOD REVEALED TO THE NATIONS

What wonderful images we have today of the reign of God! Isaiah speaks to us of a great feast—a heavenly feast—a feast of abundance with rich foods and choice wines. It is the Lord’s own affair, Isaiah explains, when God will unite all nations, dry every tear, and destroy death forever. Then, too, will the entire earth rejoice in the Lord and bask in God’s saving grace. Jesus speaks of heaven in terms of a feast as well. Here, the kingdom of heaven is likened to a king’s wedding feast given for his son. This is a feast of abundance also, with the fattened cattle prepared just so. But many of the people invited don’t want to come, so the king invites anyone who would honor his son by their presence there. **First Sacraments**

Discernment interviews with Father Selva are required for each Sacrament as we begin for Parents, children, (Godparents/Sponsors). A fully prepared student/Family will then enter into the required Sacramental classes. A second interview with Father during preparation will be required for candidates with Parents, Godparents.

We need to do planning for our Sacramental Preparation Programs. The first step is to identify the need in terms of specific families/individuals in need, particularly of First Sacraments: **Baptism, First Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation.** We will also need to identify possible participation in RCIA or Adult Confirmation.

**Baptism (Infant to under age 7)**

Requirements: Registered Parishioners, practicing the Catholic Faith (at least one parent)—Godparents must be baptized, Confirmed and Practicing. Procedure: Identify yourself and fill out a Baptism Registration Form. After the class, is completed, parents and Godparents meet with Father. If Godparents are out of town, they need to complete Preparation that is provided in their local area and provide proof. The Baptism itself can take place at any time—probably outside of Mass during the Covid restriction. The 11:00am time slot on Sunday mornings will work.

**First Communion**

The Age of Reason/seven years of age/2nd Grade are typical for the time of First Communion. If you have a child who is age qualified, E-mail (subject line: **First Communion**) with full information. We will have a Class on Fridays, or if candidates are few, we will prepare a preparation kit for home-based class with a few sessions possible workshop style.

**First Confession**

Ordinarily, by Canon Law and Diocesan policy, First Confession occurs **before** First Communion. Preparation for First Confession will be intertwined with Preparation for First Communion. If there are older Children in need of First Sacraments, submit their names so they can be prepared—perhaps in a separate class.

**Confirmation**

The age for receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation is seemingly falling from age 16 to the younger age of 10-12. We need to have a complete list of young people in the Parish in this age bracket. We will probably, this year, still focus on teens for the Sacrament.

**RCIA & RCIC**

Please submit any names of potential candidates for the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: Baptized in another Christian

Denomination wanting entry into Full Communion or Unbaptized in need of all the Sacraments of Initiation. **RCIC** is for older children in need of Baptism & First Sacraments.

**Adult Confirmation**

Baptized Catholics in need of the Sacrament of Confirmation.

**Please make sacramental needs known to Candy or Juan.**

Sacramental Preparation will follow discernment interviews with Father.

**Attention: Religious Education Parents:**

Due to safety precautions and Church policy, all children need to have a **current registration form** on file in the R. E. Office. Although classes have already started, registration is still being accepted till the end of September. **Please** make sure to register any child attending Catechism Classes this year.
