

Saint Francis Xavier Stewardship ADVANCING MISSIONARY DISCIPLESHIP (AMD)

Last July of 2023 we began the new fiscal year and the next fiscal year July of 2024 is approaching. In our monthly Financial Reports, which are published in our church Bulletin, our existing balance in the bank for General Operating expenses is very low. This fund pays salaries, utilities, insurance, maintenance, supplies, and our share of the diocese expenses through (AMD) or Advancing Missionary Discipleship. This fund has a low balance in terms of paying our monthly expenses, secondly, most of our weekend collections are deficit to cover our monthly average expenses.

Instead of a fundraising campaign for DMF, as we had in the past with goals for each parish, the diocese is saving expenses by having each parish pay a share based on their average general collection for the prior year. As a poor church, our percentage share may be less than that of any parish. When this program began, parishioners who gave separately to DMF were asked to send the same amount as additional contributions to the parish and we would have more than enough to cover this expense. That is getting forgotten and, like everyone else, the parish expenses are going up.

As a matter of stewardship, if every one of our more or less 120 (?) active families and individuals would give a minimum of \$50 per month (or one time \$600 per year) regularly, excluding your Sunday's masses giving, hopefully we can meet our expenses.

There is some misunderstanding about the AMD as part of our budget. The AMD gives the Diocese of Pueblo the ability to secure its financial base and opens up energy and resources to refocus all its efforts around Missionary Discipleship. Remember we are part of the Diocese.

There are many services at the diocese level that individual parishes cannot do on their own. The bishop is paid the same as any parish priest but does not have a parish to pay this. The Diocese operates the marriage tribunal, funds the diaconate formation program, helps with the expenses of Pueblo Catholic Charities, does training for our religious education instructors, has diocese-wide youth activities, sends publications to all registered Catholics in the diocese, supports our seminarians, pays for diocese functions at the Cathedral, participates in the Colorado Catholic Conference, and more.

The Diocese also brings missionary priests from other countries to serve here in the diocese. It is expensive to bring in foreign missionaries and they are only given a few years to stay by the government. If the Diocese wants to keep these priests for more years (especially if the parishioners are satisfied with them), the Diocese will have to apply and pay for their visa extension. If the missionaries go back to their countries of origin, the Diocese needs to bring in other missionaries.

There are two possible suggestions or options for us to help. First, an increase in monthly or annual giving as outlined above will work. Second, you can also donate specifically to AMD in addition to your normal contribution to the parish. This goes into a special fund and is used to pay our share of AMD. As a result, the amount the parish pays from the general fund is decreased by what is donated to AMD and those donations do not count as part of the general income for determining our contribution to AMD next fiscal year.

My dear parishioners, please remember and help your church SFX. We will keep you posted each month concerning the parish finances and also regular reports on the number of donors, the amount collected, and the amount forwarded to the diocese.

The parish is also inviting those parishioners not yet registered to please register in our church as a fully registered parishioner of SFX church. As well as those registered parishioners please re-update your registration form. It's been a decade ago the last time we updated our parish registration. Rest assured that your prayers and intentions are always remembered in our daily adoration and prayer before the Blessed Sacrament.

You can call the office to register if you want to pay separately for AMD or use our QR code apps for online donations. If you have any concerns or special intentions, let me know or Cathy, our Parish Secretary. Fr. Peter is willing to offer his private mass on Monday mornings for the intentions of the donors.
