



DECREE

By the authority of His Excellency the Most Rev. Stephen J. Berg, D.D., Bishop of the Diocese of Pueblo, I, Very Rev. Derrek Scott, Vicar General, issue the following decree regarding the pastoral administration of the Mission of St. Aloysius in Rye, Colorado.

Whereas, after a thorough study, prayers, and consultation including discussions with Rev. Mark Bettinger, Pastor of Holy Family Parish, and Rev. Peter Abogado, SSS, Pastor of St. Francis Xavier Parish, it has been determined in accordance with the mission and pastoral needs of the diocese, the following steps are necessary:

Effective January 1, 2025, the Mission of St. Aloysius in Rye, CO, shall be relocated from Holy Family Parish, Pueblo, CO, to St. Francis Xavier Parish, Pueblo, CO. This decision is made in accordance with the pastoral care and best interest of the faithful entrusted to this mission as provided for in canon 519, which states that the Pastor has the responsibility of fostering the spiritual welfare of the parish and its members, ensuring that their pastoral needs are effectively met;

Furthermore, all financial matters related to the Mission of St. Aloysius including collection, and stewardship of assets should be administered by the Pastor of St. Francis Xavier Parish, Pueblo, CO. This measure is taken in accordance with canon 530, which grants the Pastor the authority to administer the temporal goods of the parish, ensuring their proper use for the good of the faithful;

The faithful of the Mission of St. Aloysius in Rye, CO, shall continue to receive pastoral and spiritual care under the jurisdiction of St. Francis Xavier Parish, with the full support and supervision of Rev. Peter Abogado, SSS. In compliance with canon 528, which requires pastors to fulfill their pastoral obligations diligently, Rev. Peter Abogado will ensure that all sacramental and pastoral needs of the mission are met.

This decree shall be communicated to the parishioners of both Holy Family Parish and St. Francis Xavier Parish, as well as to all those affected by this change, and be made publicly known. This is in accordance with canon 533, which requires the Pastor to inform the faithful of changes in the pastoral administration of the parish.

In accordance with canon 289, which calls for the Bishop to act as the principal Shepherd, the decision to transfer this mission is made with the goal of enhancing the pastoral care and ensuring the spiritual welfare of the community. May the faithful, under the guidance of the Holy Spirit, receive this change with understanding and cooperation, continuing their commitment to Christ and His Church.
